I wish David and Michelle all the luck in the world and hope they both return home as soon as possible and in the same condition as they left.



Amplification is not that big a problem for me , It is clarification of speech. I can hear people speak but what I hear is so distorted that I cant make out what is being said. When people speak slowly and pronounce their words then I can understand most of what is being said.

My blood tests are showing normal.. The Dr. makes sure the white blood count is normal. One of the side effects of the therapy is low white blood cell count and that would make me open for infections. So far I seem to be tolerating the chemo O.K.

I was speaking to Hy before the unveiling and did not know who he was. He looks so old and crippled I feel sorry for him . He probably thinks I look the same. I remember Sadie and Sid. I did not know Sid and Irving worked together. Did Sid have the same problem from the asbestos?
