I knew about the unveiling this Sunday the 17th. Jackie has a bad cold all week and I hope she is well by then. It really doesnt seem like a year.

I only packed the outside of the carton of the globe. I did not open the carton and I hope nothing was broken. The MFG. packed it well.

I remember someone sending me cookies when I was overseas but I don't remember who. They were just plain boxed cookies. I enjoyed them just the same.

I started my therapy again and I think this is the fourth month and eight more to go. I take four injections at one time five days in a row, then nothing for the rest of the month. Then two days before I start the injections again I take a blood test. I hope it all works.
